



Bring Your Bills — bringing your service

Everything you need, on one page. Free events run by South East Community Links.

Four links. You only need the first one to get started — **no code, no account, no login.**

1 Register your service for an event

About five minutes. **No code needed** — this is the way in.

Pick the event, say how many of you are coming, and write a sentence on how you can help. A logo is optional. SECL checks it and emails you back — and if it's your first time, that email contains your **service code**, which you'll need below.

2 On the day — record who you helped

About twenty seconds per person. Needs your service code.

Open it on your own device before you leave for the event and check it loads. Enter your code once and it's remembered. It never records anyone's name or contact details.

3 Afterwards — your own numbers

Needs your service code.

People you helped, an estimated value of the debt and savings you supported, and breakdowns by issue and event. Your organisation only — no service sees another's.

4 Hosting an event, or need a date changed?

Needs your service code. SECL approves it before anything goes public.

One address to remember instead of four: bringyourbills.org.au/hub.html

Enter your service code there and your own links appear — and the survey and your numbers page won't ask for the code again on that device.

Lost your service code? Email byb@secl.org.au and SECL will look it up. It looks like ANGE - 7K2M-BQF and came with your confirmation email.

Never been to a Bring Your Bills event? Start at step 1 — you don't need a code for it, and approving it is what creates yours.
